Application

Please link to the form below and **complete your application no later than January 16, 2015**. Applications submitted by the deadline will undergo a blind review and selection process. We anticipate that we will receive more applications than available shifts, so unfortunately we will not be able to accommodate everyone who applies. Once the schedule is fully staffed, names will be added to the conference volunteer wait list. We will notify potential volunteers by email regarding their status by February 1, 2015.

Registration Fee

Volunteers will be asked to pay a nominal fee of \$100 to attend the conference. Applicants who are selected for a volunteer assignment will be sent instructions to register at the reduced volunteer rate (Volunteer: \$100).
